


Bottom illustration shows top view

The result - the two flaps are now facing you






When the front flap is pulled out the inner part of the paper will form valley and mountain folds as shown in 20c

Inspiration

I was looking at Christmas decorations in a department store and I saw a magnificent angel with out stretched wings holding a trumpet in the air. When I looked closer, the model was formed from angular shapes which reminded me of origami. However I was put off by the price of £40.00 for this plastic model. In the same store I bought a DVD of Marillion performing their Marbles album live. In the lead singer explained the meaning of their song 'Angelina'. He said that it was based upon the idea of there existing a nurse to heal non physical injuries - a soul healer.

After watching that track the image of the angel model and the idea of a healer for the soul merged and I switched off the DVD and began to make this model - Its not meant to be a literal interpretation of the Marillion character - more a merging of the two ideas.

How to display

The model is intended to be hung. There is a flap between the wings (as folded in step 26) which can be punctured for the use of thread. Hang from the ceiling using blu tac or from a Christmas tree. Also can be supported by a wire stand.
