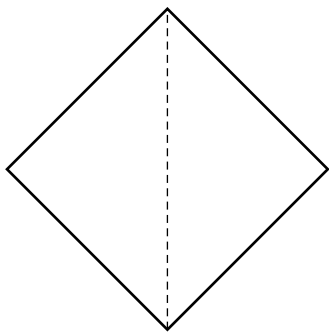
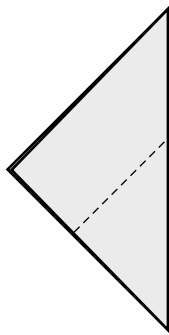


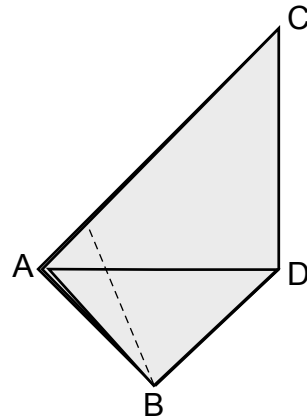
Minimalist Christmas Tree



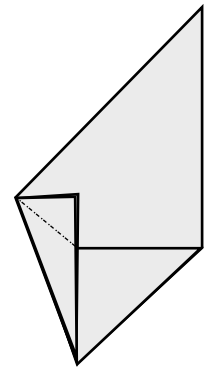
1. White side up. Valley fold along the diagonal.



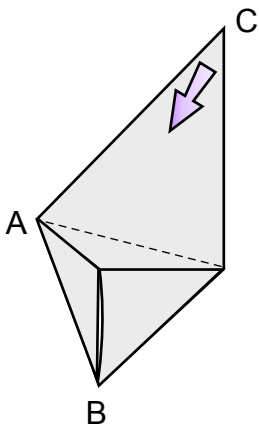
2. Valley fold the bottom corner across to the left point.



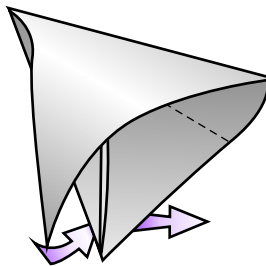
3. Enlarged view. Valley fold the left side across so that A - B is parallel with C - D.



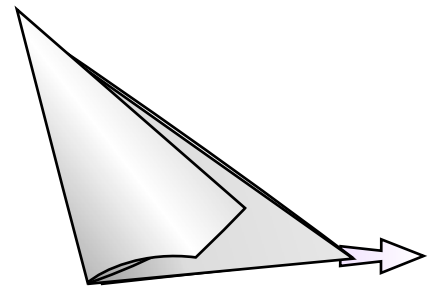
4. Mountain fold the point behind.



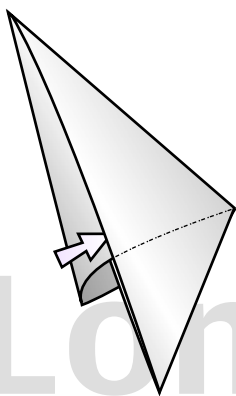
5. Pull the top corner (C) down keeping the valley fold smooth (i.e. don't flatten it). The idea here is to create a cone with A as the point.



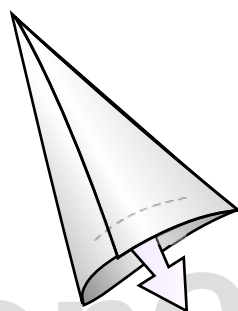
6. Enlarged view. Keep pulling it round to form the cone.



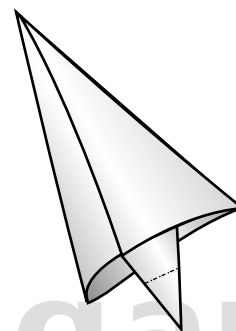
7. Once it's all the way round you should have a 3D cone on the left and a triangle of paper behind. Unfold.



8. Repeat steps 5 - 7 this time tucking point B into the flap between A and C (see step 5). Mountain fold the bottom corner into the cone to hold it in shape.



9. Valley fold the flap back out to begin forming the base.



10. Mountain fold the point behind.

11. Finished Christmas Tree.
